Scriptures for the week: First Kings 19:9-18, Psalm 27, 2 Peter 1:13-21, Mark 9:2-9

Other notes for the week: Last Sunday after the Epiphany. Lent begins with Ash Wednesday this Wednesday. What Lenten disciplines is the Lord asking you to undertake this year: fasting, prayer and alms?

Collect for the Week: O God, who before the passion of your only-begotten Son revealed his glory upon the holy mountain: Grant that we, beholding by faith the light of his countenance, may be strengthened to bear our cross, and be changed into his likeness from glory to glory; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen.



Warm Up Questions: What mountain or mountains have you visited? Which ones were your favorite? Why?

Think of someone whose advice and counsel you seek. Who is that person? What makes that person special to you?

Into The Bible Questions

First Kings 19:9-18

How many books of Kings are there? What is the First Book of Kings about? Name 3 major characters of First Kings

Where was Elijah when the word of the Lord came to him? Where did Elijah go next? What passed by him? What was the last thing to pass by Elijah? Where was the voice of the Lord?

Psalm 27

In Psalm 27, Verses 5-6 the psalmist asks one thing of the Lord. What are other examples of things that people in the Bible ask of the Lord? Example: Solomon

What things would you ask of the Lord? Which one thing would you choose? Why

Second Peter 1:13-21

Who was the Peter who wrote this letter? How many Letters did Peter write?

What event is Peter describing in this lesson? Where else can this event be found in the bible?
Who else was there when it happened?

Mark 9:2-9

What event is described in this gospel lesson? Who are the main characters in the story? Where else is the event described in the bible?

What Feast of the Church is described here? What day is it celebrated? Take a moment and look up an icon of that feast day. What does the icon show?
